Filamentality Basic-Core Medical Terminology WebQuest

For this assignment, you will be exploring several websites to gather information that you will need to answer a set of questions based on Basic-Core Medical Terminology. The questions will challenge you to understand the terminology used to define and describe the anatomy, disease processes, treatment, and medications.

This assignment will build on the knowledge gained from the text reading assignment, terminology exercises, and the PowerPoint on basic-core medical terminology.

Visit each of the websites listed and explore for the information that will answer the related questions. The more you explore the more information you will acquire and this will strengthen your understanding of basic-core medical terminology.

Upon the completion of this assignment, you will need to provide a word document to the instructor that contains the answers to the following questions or tasks:

- 1. The student will watch the tutorial and provide answers to the following questions or tasks:
 - a. Why is understanding Medical terminology so important?
 - b. List 5 beginnings (prefixes) from the tutorial.
 - c. List 5 endings (suffixes) from the tutorial.
 - d. List 5 abbreviations from the tutorial.
 - e. List 5 body parts described in the tutorial.

The word document will end with a reflection paragraph that expresses the students reaction to the tutorial. For example, was the information helpful, was it delivered in an understandable way, and how would the student improve it (the tutorial) if they were given the opportunity to do so.

2. Using the flash cards on this site to find the words that define seven (7) colors and the numbers 1,2,3,and 4.

The student will be required to list the seven (7) colors they find and their corresponding definitions, as found on the flashcards in the word document created for this Basic Medical Terminology Filamentality assignment.

The student will then be required to list the four (4) numbers (1,2,3,and 4)and their corresponding definitions, as found on the flashcards in the word document created for this Basic Medical Terminology Filamentality assignment.

3. The students will play the hangman game and make note of the eight words they find in the game. Once the student has all eight (8) words they will list them in a word document that was created for this Basic Medical Terminology Filamentality assignment and write a paragraph about how the words are related.

After answering, the questions and performing the tasks of the WebQuest provide a concluding paragraph to the document that provides a reflection of your WebQuest experience.

The word document must be submitted via email to the instructors' email address by the due date for the assignment. Late submission will not be accepted, unless the instructor granted prior approval.

The word document should be written in clear and understandable grammar with Verdana, Calibri, or Arial font no larger than 12pt and no smaller than 10pt.
